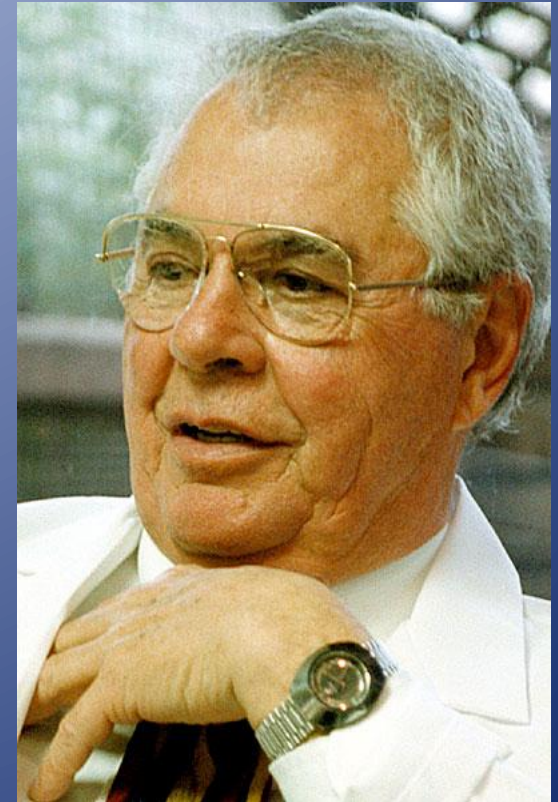

wonderful sense of humor.



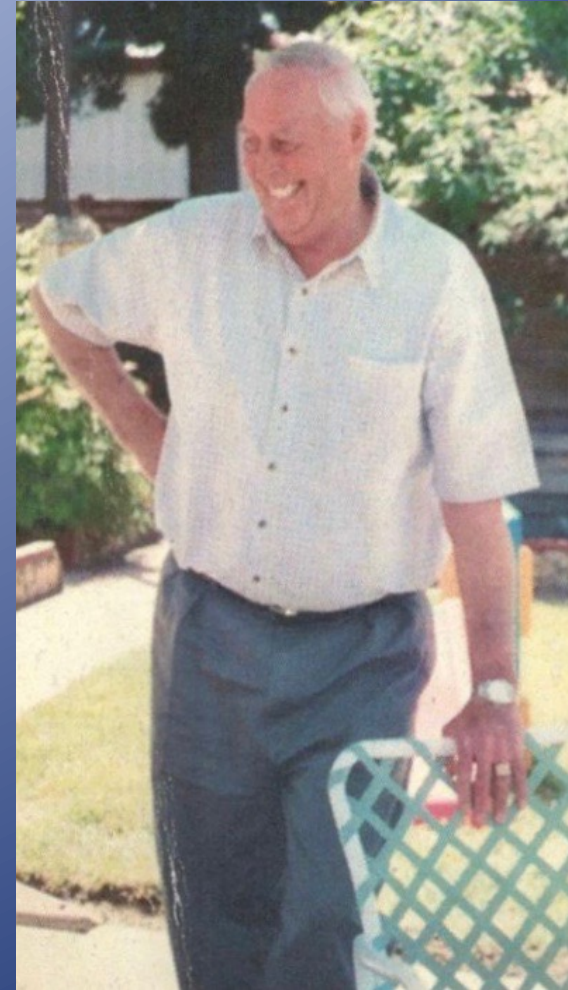
# Elwood Alfred Schutz

committed Rotarian.

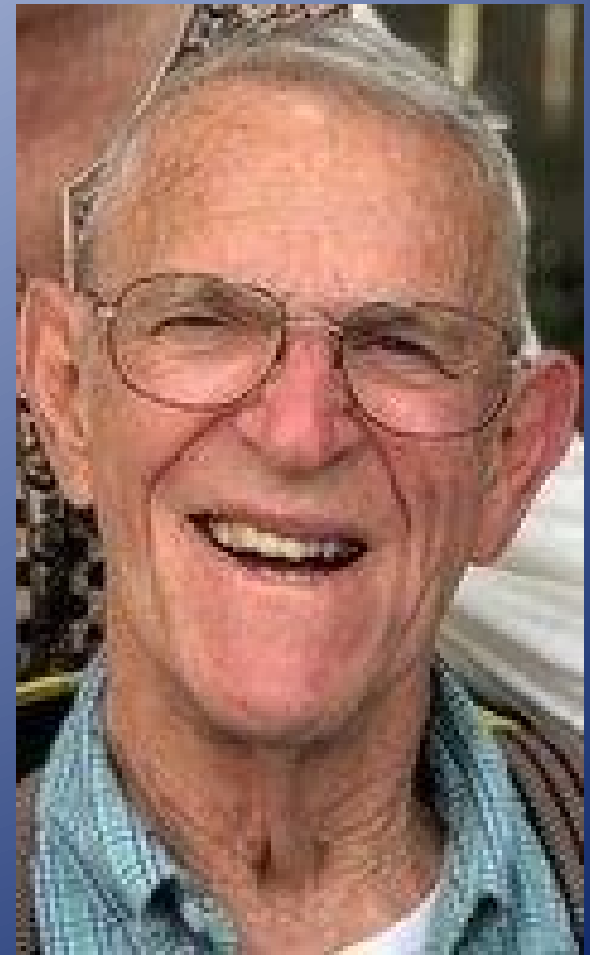


# Galen Chastain

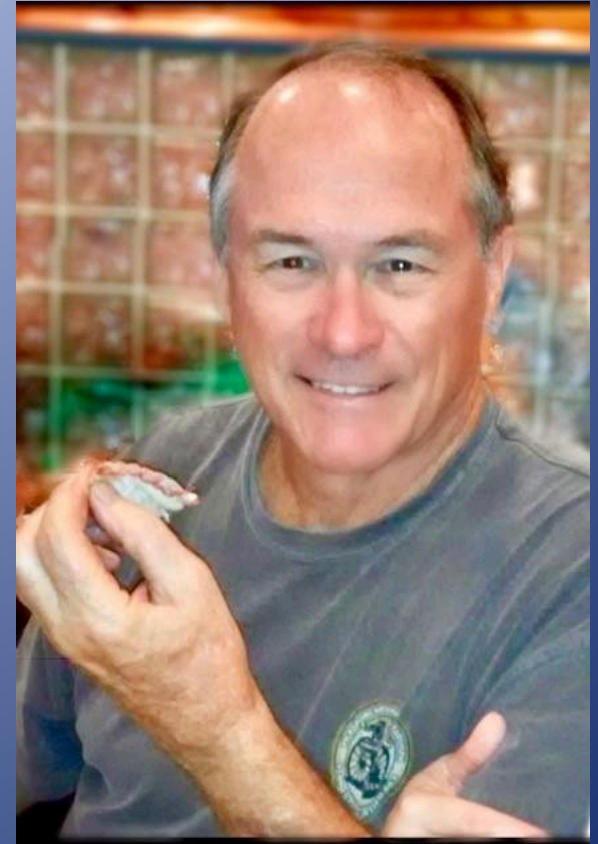
# Marshall Bishop
